Delineation of Employment Skills:

Project: Curriculum and Activities to Instill Employment Skills in Logan County Students

Goal: To develop and plan curricula and activities that will instill employment skills and introduce students to multiple career opportunities.

Action Steps: As mandated by Sub H.B. 49, the BAC will collaboratively develop curriculum and activities to instill employment skills.

- The BAC will plan and execute several career exploration activities for high school students.
- The BAC will develop and implement a 3E Campaign to inform students.

Changes in the Economy, Job Market and Future Job Availability:

Project: Changes in the Economy, Job Market and Future Job Availability

Goal: Explain how the business advisory council will identify essential data elements to study historical and future changes to the economy and job market.

Action Steps: As mandated by Sub. H.B. 49, the BAC will advise local boards of education on the economy, the job market, and the types of employment in which future jobs are most likely to be available.

The Business Advisory Council will prepare annual reports to be distributed to participating school districts' boards of education to provide insight on efforts, progress, and collaboration. Participating boards of education will have the opportunity to provide input into the council's plans and efforts.
